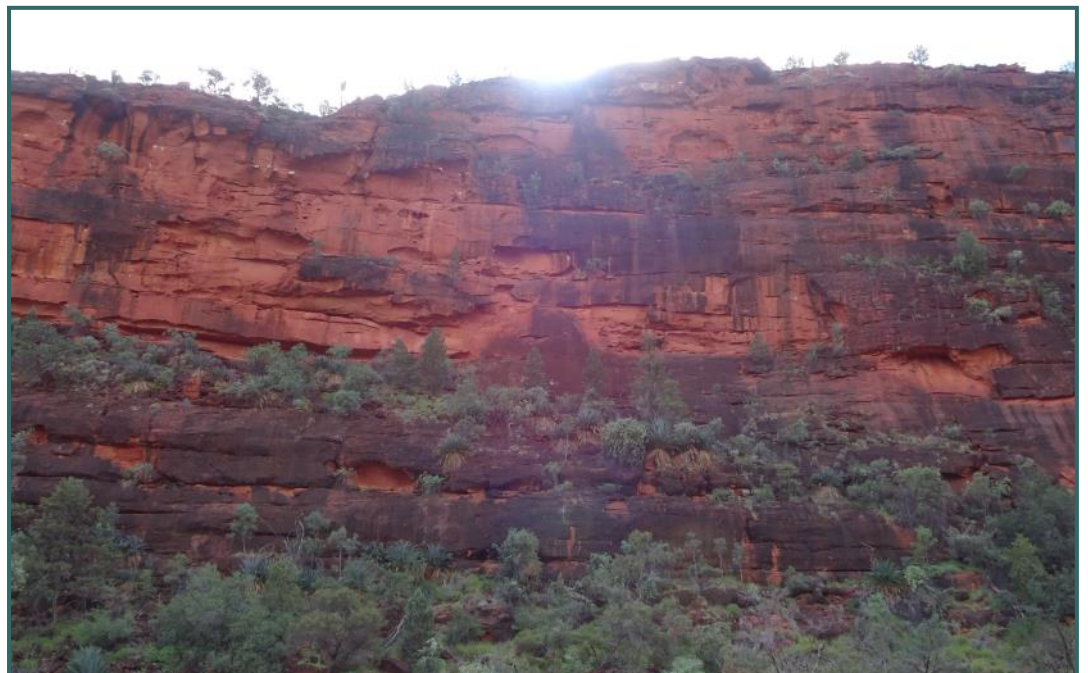

This listing refers to the entire population of MacDonnell Ranges Cycad within the Finke Gorge National Park, celebrating the rare and localised distribution of the species.

This species is endemic to the Northern Territory and is classified as Near Threatened. As this population is situated within the Finke Gorge National Park, it falls under the Environment Protection and Conservation (EPBC) Act 1999. Consequently, the Northern Territory Parks and Wildlife Commission NT has developed a recovery plan for the species, which is aimed at maintaining or improving the current conservation status. The Cycad is a very slow growing and a long-lived species, with some specimens surviving for well over 1000 years.
