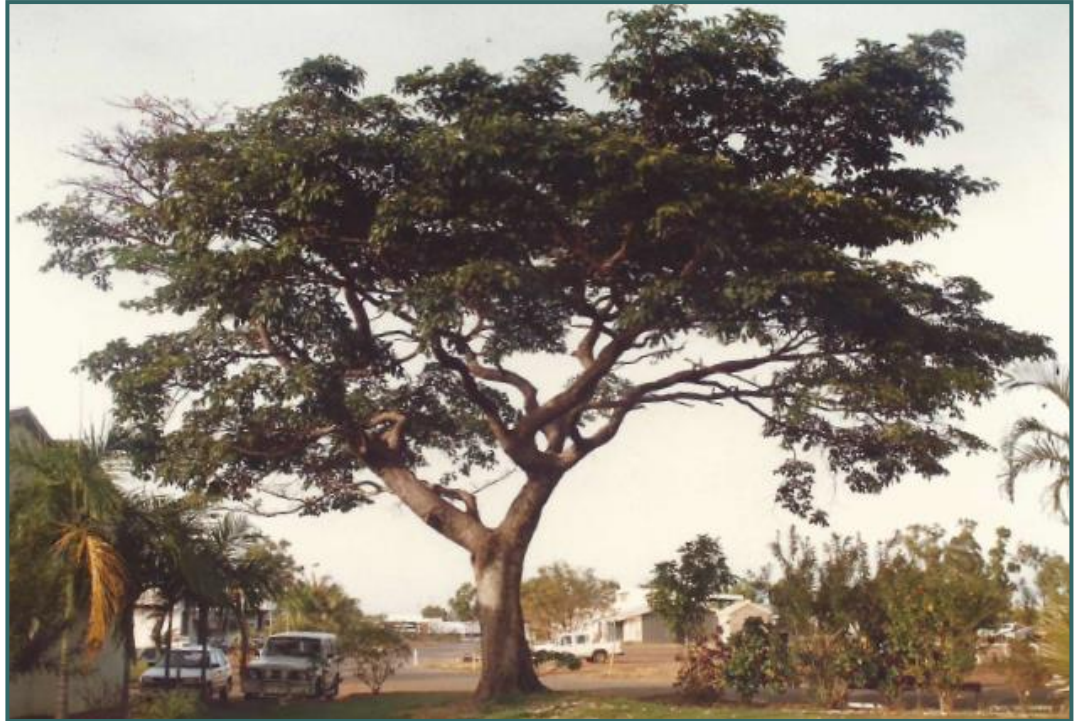

*Chlorophora excelsa*, a native of Africa, was introduced into the NT in 1959. The species was trialed as a potential forestry tree in plots near the abattoirs, however conditions were too dry. This specimen was planted in 1962 as part of a major landscaping project by the RAAF. As one of the few remaining trees of this species, this specimen is a reminder of past unsuccessful attempts at introducing commercial forestry into northern Australia.
