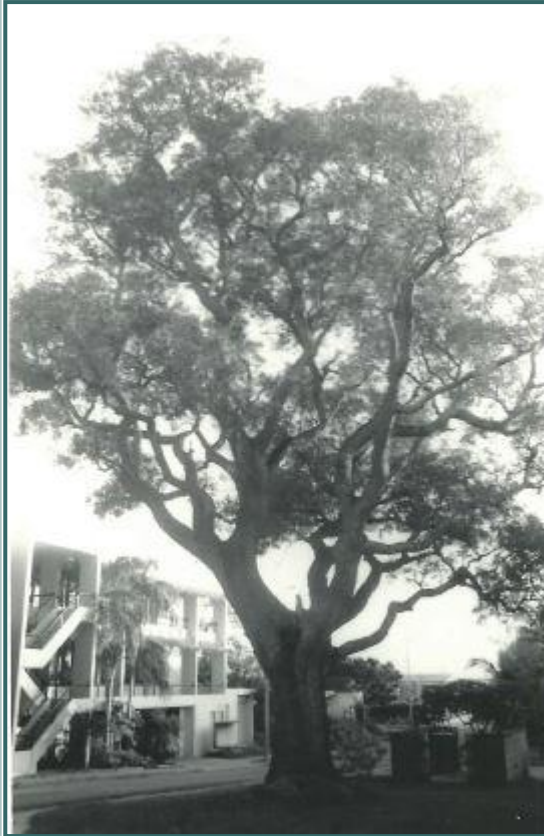

This tree was part of Darwin peninsula's original vegetation and was most likely the oldest and largest specimen of its type that still existed in the Darwin region.

It was nominated to the register in 1986 by former Lord Mayor, the late George Brown. Note the Banyan Fig which had taken root in the fork of the tree. The tree was Heritage listed in 2006 however the tree sadly died of old age in 2018 and was removed.
