The large Poinciana which dominated the front garden of the Hotel Darwin (built in 1936) was planted in 1946 by Mrs. Chrissie Paspalis. Like the hotel, it was damaged by Cyclone Tracy but survived to live on as part of the history of Darwin. In 1989 it was heavily looped due to falling branches.
