George Brown, Darwin's tree doyen, reported that this *Ficus* was significant as "a survivor of at least three cyclones and several attempts by various people in government departments to have it removed". He went on to say that it was part of the original flora of the Darwin peninsula and should be considered to be part of the streetscape.

Unfortunately this tree was bulldozed in 1990 and now no longer exists.
