This group of various native species are remnants of the native savannah vegetation of the Darwin area. The well developed skirts of dead leaves retained by the pandanus are testimony to the fire protection provided by the urban environment. Groups of trees like these once provided valuable habitat to birds, lizards and small mammals. Today only one tree remains, the *Eucalyptus*.
