In the 1990's local resident Bill Panton recognised that this one hectare of monsoon vine forest was actually a remnant of a former forest which had extended an area of 20 hectares less then 30 years ago.

Funding was secured and the Leanyear Landcare Group was formed with the aim to reverse the damage to the Vine Forest caused by seasonal fires, cyclones and Mission Grass weed invasion.

The group, with the help of local school children managed to establish over 5000 trees and expand the forest from the initial one hectare to now 5 hectares of lush forest consisting of over 200 plant species.
