This tree was planted on the 29th of June 1986, at the re-opening of the Katherine Railway Station building. The Katherine Rail Precinct site is of high historic and social significance and contains a number of heritage structures.

Lil Tindal and Tom Kelly planted it to commemorate the original tree planted by the late George Tindal, Katherine's longest-serving station master (1939-1949, 1952-1967). Lil Tindal was George Tindal's wife. Tom Kelly was a railway Fetter who worked the line for many years and was very well respected within the community.
